As an athlete representing the Academy, I will:

- 1. Embrace the highest ideals of sportsmanship, ethical conduct, and fair play.
- 2. Show fairness, honesty, integrity and respect to all athletes, officials, teammates, parents, and coaches while demonstrating appropriate behavior at all times.
- 3. Respect the property of others and facilities, and not willfully cause damage.
- 4. Dedicate myself to being a student-athlete, while in school.
- 5. Be aware that nothing worthwhile is accomplished without hard work and the sincere desire to succeed.

  This means trying to attend all practices and sometimes sacrificing outside extra-curricular activities.
- 6. Treat my coaches with respect and discourage fellow athletes from challenging the coach's authority.
- 7. Refrain from the use of language or actions that degrade, bait, discriminate, and/or intimidate others or myself.
- 8. Thoroughly understand and uphold the rules of the sport.
- 9. Value and respect different points of views, from both teammates and coaches.
- 10. Agree that use of drugs and alcohol are strictly prohibited when representing the Academy in any capacity.
